The IG is not your friend

Office of Special Counsel Investigations

OSC focuses on whistleblower reprisal and other prohibited personnel practices.

OSC has the authority to prosecute independently of the employing agency.

Agency and manager positions on a whistleblower reprisal investigation are not always aligned.

OSC will allow a lawyer during the interview.

EEO Complaints

The agency does not always represent the interests of managers in the EEO system.

Some EEO complaints can be sensitive or concern mistakes or problems unrelated to discrimination.

The EEO system operates separately from management and keeps even frivolous complaints in the system for years.

PLI will provide an attorney to guide the manager through the EEO process.

Professional Liability Insurance Covers:

Administrative and Disciplinary Matters

- Up to \$200,000 in attorneys' fees for disciplinary actions including investigations

Lawsuits

- Up to \$1,000,000 or \$2,000,000 to satisfy judgments
- Attorneys' fees to defend the lawsuit if the Department of Justice declines representation
- In certain cases, a lawyer to monitor the Department of Justice's representation

Criminal Proceedings

- Up to \$100,000 to defend criminal charges
