
Ethics in Brief: THE HATCH ACT & INTERNET "BLOGS"



What You Absolutely Need to Know About Writing "Blogs" in Your Personal Capacity, as a Private Citizen:

<u>Question</u>: May I write a blog expressing support (or opposition) of a political candidate or a political party?

<u>Answer</u>: YES, you may write a blog, in your personal capacity as a private citizen. But you are subject to the following limitations: You <u>may express your personal opinions</u> about political candidates, political parties, or partisan political groups, <u>but you may NOT do so</u>:

- While on duty,
- While in a Federal building, and
- You cannot refer to your official USDA title or authority in the blog.

So, you may write a blog, in your personal capacity, off- duty, and off-site. BUT make sure that you do not solicit or receive any political contributions at any time. In other words, you should not ask readers to make contributions to a political party, candidate, or partisan political group. Also, don't post links to the contribution page of any of those entities' or individuals' campaign websites.

Career-SESer are further restricted and should contact the Office of Ethics <u>before</u> posting anything on their blog concerning a partisan political campaign.
